

Apply Now

- Apply to more than 1 school
- Visit campuses
- Write down username and passwords for each school
- Use your legal name and have your social security number ready
- Do not use your school email address
- Accept all offers for admissions and scholarships

Missions, Military or Humanitarian Service

► College Bound students planning to serve should do the following.

- 1. Apply to all universities of possible interest.
- 2. Accept all scholarships offers and admissions.
- 3. Complete the deferral process for each university
- Students that follow these steps will have scholarship offers and admissions waiting for them when they return. Students that do not complete all of the above will start over when they return, including retaking the ACT.

BYU Application

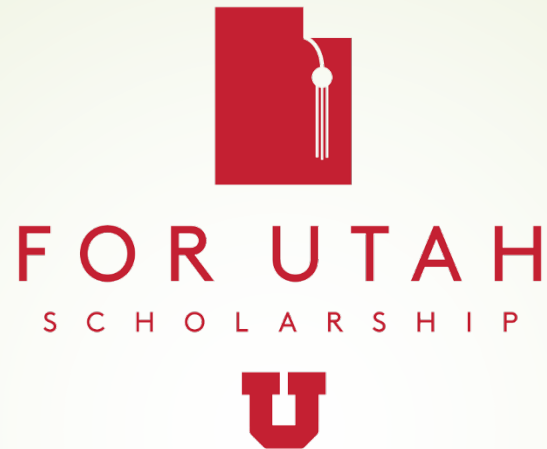
- ▶ Priority deadline, Nov 1.
 - ▶ If you want to get in, meet or beat this deadline
- ▶ Final deadline December 15th (scholarship deadline as well)
 - ▶ Start early because essays and recommendations take time.
 - ▶ Avoid redundancy in essays
 - ▶ Strong essays show an understanding of the Mission and Aims of a BYU education. For essay writing tips, visit essays.byu.edu
 - ▶ Get it done ASAP if you plan to live on campus
 - ▶ ACT Scores are optional
 - ▶ Scholarships are a separate application

University of Utah Application

- Due December 1st (scholarship deadline as well, includes honors college)
- Now using Common App (no separate scholarship application)
 - Application is free, select “my permanent address is in the state of Utah”
 - ACT Test optional for both enrollment and scholarships
 - Academic scholarships need a 3.7+; looking for academic rigor (AP, CE, honors classes)
- Transcript sent through Common App
- \$300 deposit due by May 1st (even if deferring)

WHO QUALIFIES?

- Utah residents
- Need to apply for admissions by Dec. 1st
- First-time freshmen interested in attending the U
- High school average GPA of at least 3.2
- Annual completion of the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and subsequent Pell Grant eligibility
- Complete FAFSA deadline Feb. 1st to get this scholarship!



USU Application

- December 1st Deadline
 - Application is free in the month of October with code: USUUCAW23
 - Transcripts can be sent through UTREX and decision will be faster
 - ACT test optional
- Scholarship deadline December 1st
 - Fill out FAFSA prior to deadline for needs-based scholarships
 - \$200 deposit due by April 1st

Utah State Need Based Scholarships



Must fill out a separate application

You must have applied and been accepted for admission before you will be considered for this scholarship. Apply as early as possible!



Must fill out a FAFSA

It is necessary to fill out the FAFSA, but you do not need to qualify for FAFSA to get a need-based scholarship from USU.



UVU Application

- March 1st Scholarship Deadline
 - Will use ACT Super score, but must request
 - Highest sub scores added together
 - Social Security Number is optional
 - Update ACT and GPA until March 1st

Weber State Scholarships

- Edge Scholarship
 - 12 CE credits with 3.0 Cumulative GPA
 - \$2,000 per year
 - Maintain full-time status (12 credits) and a 2.5 WSU cumulative GPA.
- Academic Scholarships
 - Qualify based off the scholarship index
 - 8 semester scholarships
 - Maintain full-time status (12 credits) and a 2.5 WSU cumulative GPA
 - Automatically considered for the merit scholarship with admissions application
 - Apply for FAFSA for more scholarship options

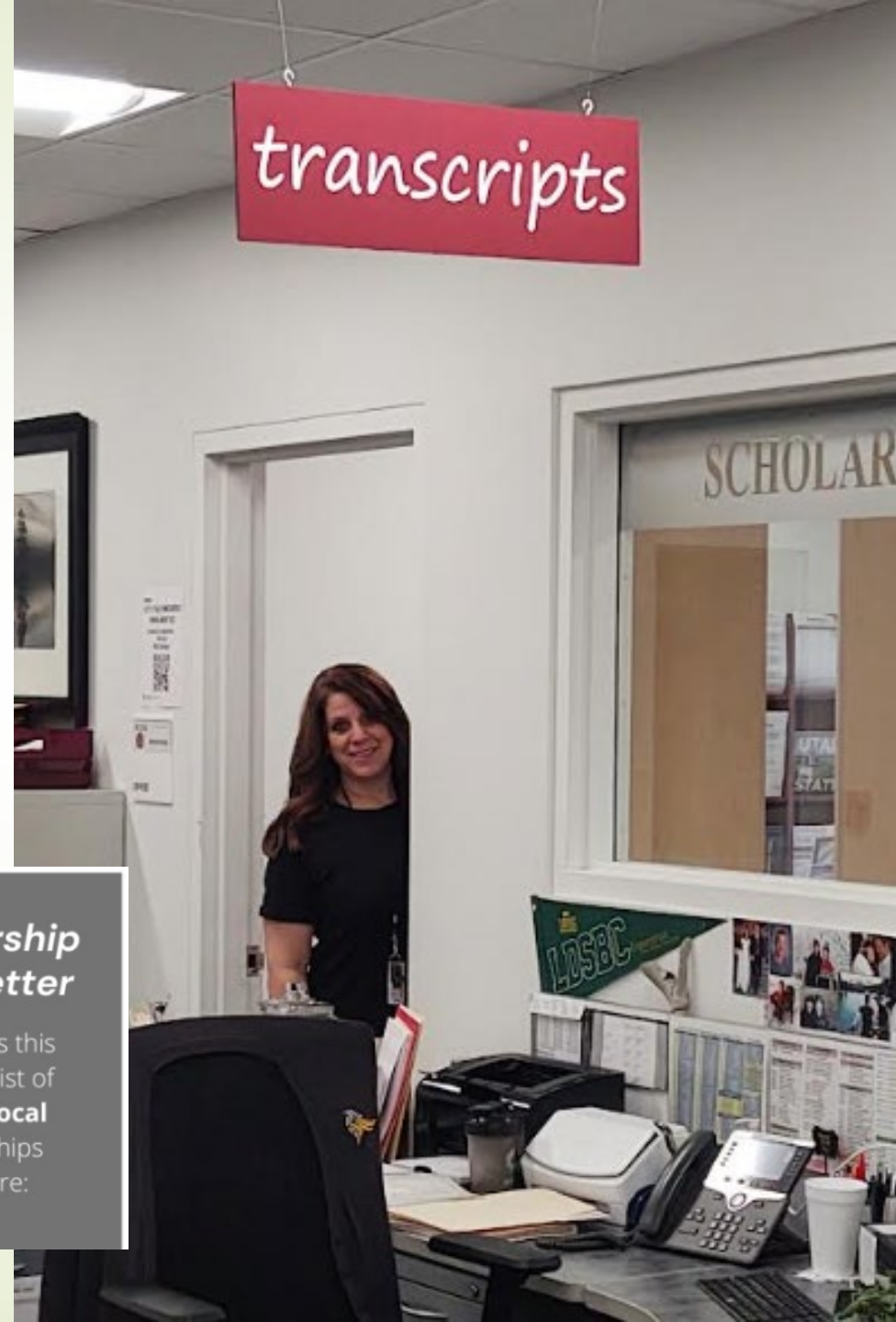

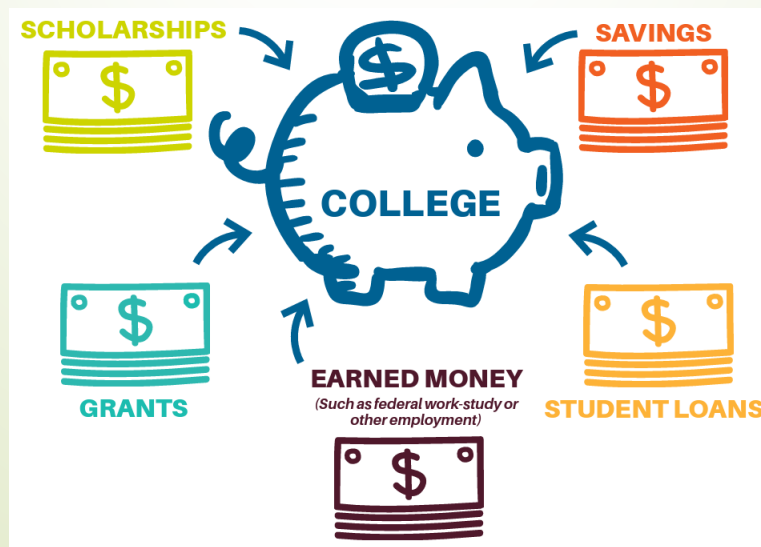

Scholarships/Financial Aid

➤ Opportunity Scholarship

- Earn a 3.3 cumulative high school GPA
- Complete 3 advanced courses (see next question for more details about eligible courses)
- Complete 1 Advanced Placement (AP), International Baccalaureate (IB), or Concurrent Enrollment (CE) course in each of the core areas of high school graduation:
 - **Math,**
 - **Science, and**
 - **Language Arts**
- Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)
- Graduate from a Utah high school

➤ Other Scholarships:

- Local Scholarships – see the school scholarship webpage for links to these awards.
- Davis Foundation Scholarships - are available only to Viewmont High School students. They will be available in April.

- FAFSA Completion Night, Monday, February 5th in Media Center Lab 3-5 pm
 - Pell Grants
 - Student Loans
 - Work Study



FAFSA Tips



- Use your full Legal Name
- Know your Social Security Number
- Use your personal email, not school/student email
- Create and write down your FSA ID for future use
- FAFSA Completion Night
 - Monday, February 5th (during PTC)
 - 3:00 pm- 5:00 pm in the Media Center
