

2021 VIEWMONT BOYS SOCCER DISCLOSURE

The Viewmont High School soccer program is excited for the upcoming season and to have your student interested in participating. We hope to be able to help your student succeed and grow on the soccer field, in the classroom, and as an individual.

Every season the boys team will carry between 28 and 37 players. Tryouts will be Monday, March 1st and Tuesday, March 2nd. Monday will have two sessions, one in the morning held in the big gym, and the afternoon on the soccer field. Tuesday will only have one session, in the afternoon.

Required practice will be every Monday through Friday. Practices are mandatory unless the athlete is ill. Any other reason for missing practice will be handled on a case by case basis. Practice will be held 3 p.m. to 5 p.m. If a practice time is changed, then your student will be notified in advance. There is also the possibility that we will be in the weight room one weekday morning and Saturday morning every week. That will be determined later. On game days, the athlete will be with the team until around 7:30 p.m. and will be expected to ride the bus back to the school after each game.

Academics and attendance are top priorities for the Viewmont Soccer program. If a player misses any part of the school day without telling a coach beforehand, they will not play in any game that day. If a player receives a truancy at any time during the season, that player will be suspended for one game. If truanies persist, additional games may be missed. If a player receives an F at midterm, that player has up to one week to raise that grade before suspension from practices and/or games will be implemented.

In addition to the above requirements, there are other non-season events that are not required but are suggested. These events are as follows:
