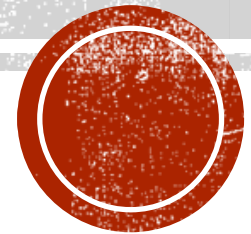

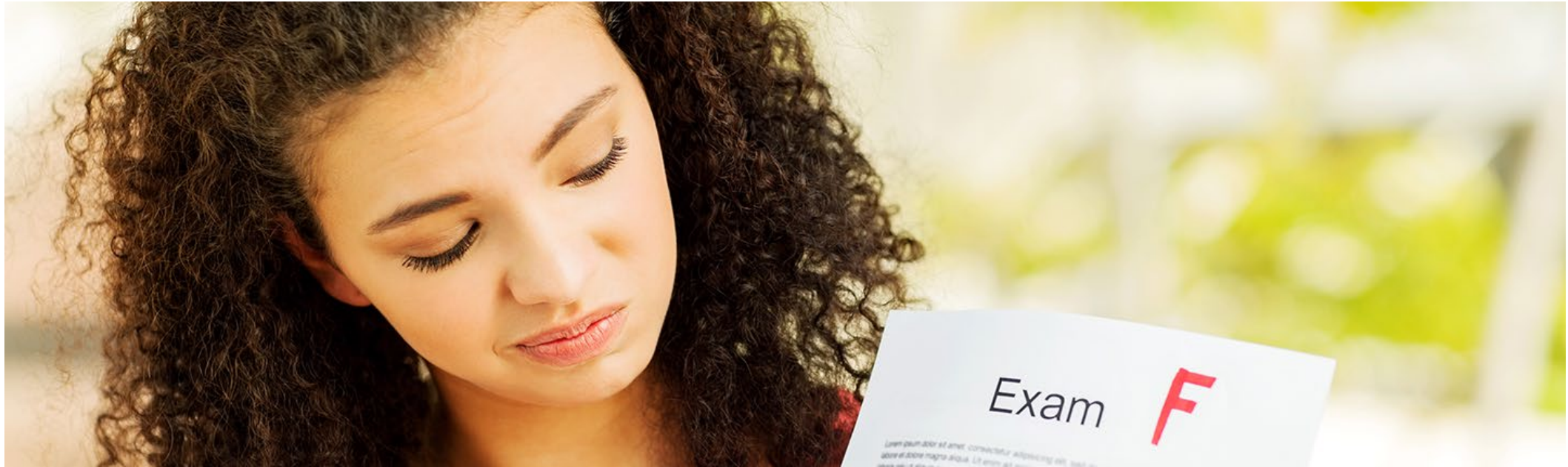

GRADUATION WITH HONORS

- **Citizenship Honors (Peacock Braid):** Complete grades 9-12 without receiving any U's
- **Academic Honors (Silver Braid):** Meet graduation requirements and have a cumulative GPA of 3.60-3.799 through 3rd term.
- **High Academic Honors (Gold Braid):** Meet graduation requirements and have a cumulative GPA of 3.80-3.999 through 3rd term.
- **Academic Distinction (White Braid):** Meet graduation requirements and have a cumulative GPA of 4.0 through 3rd term.
- ***For Distinction, High Honors, or Honors, you must take at least 5 Honors, AP, or Core CE classes)***

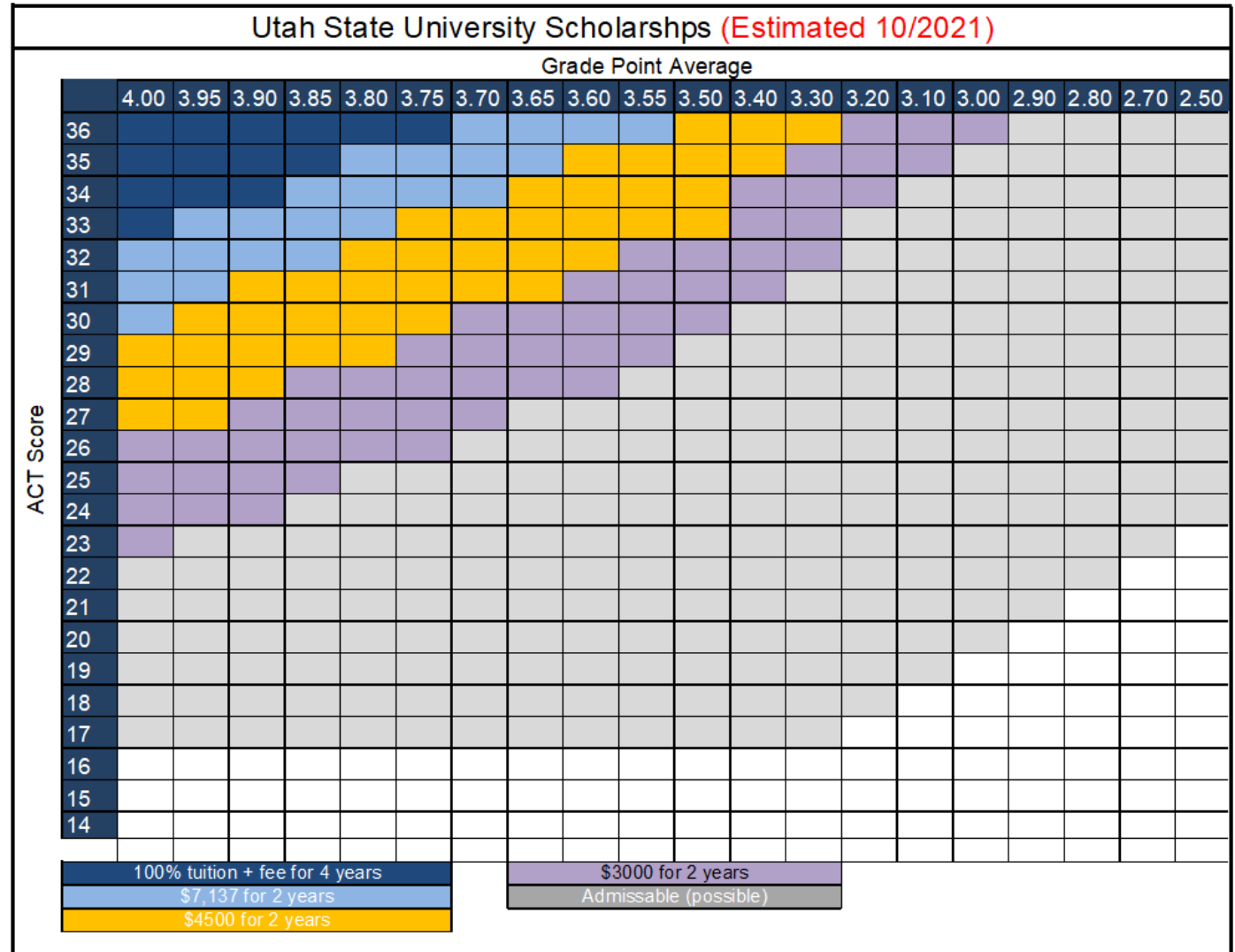

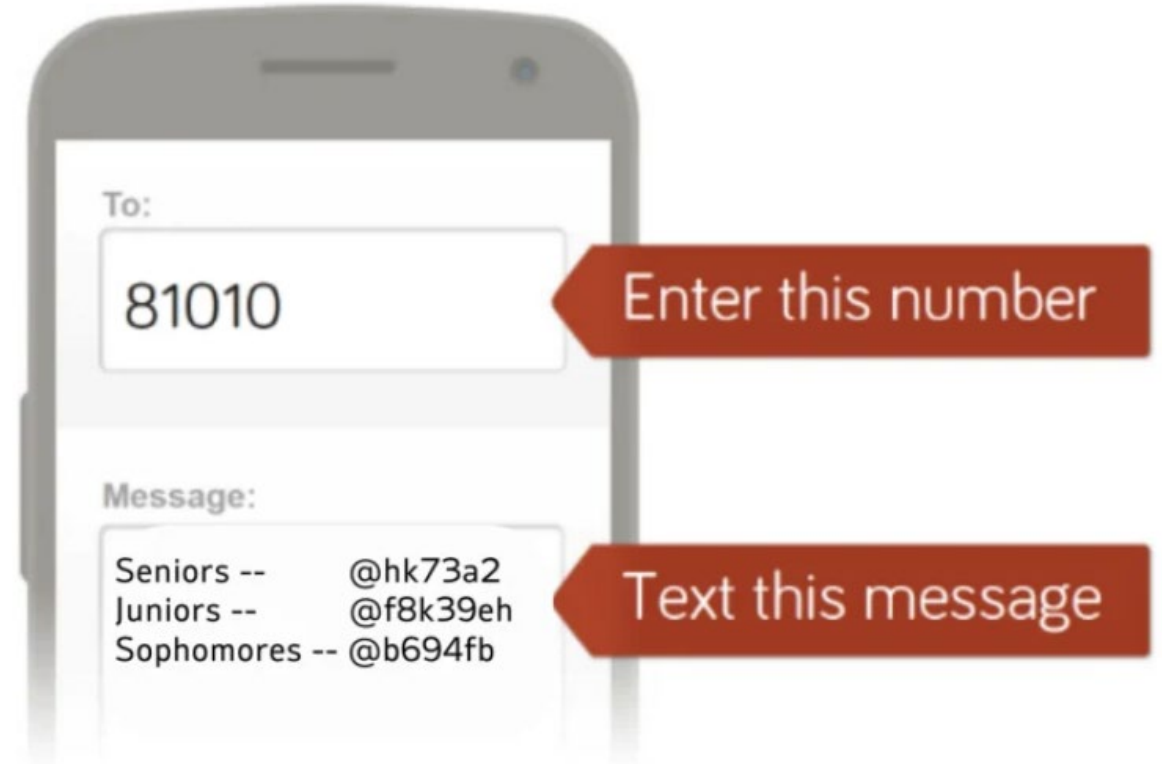

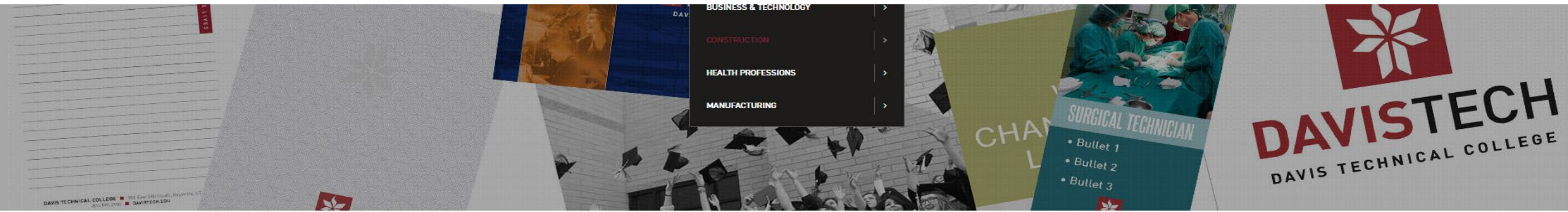
