**Action Items:**

1. Approval of March 15, 2017 community council minutes. Motion to approve Tanja Watts – 2<sup>nd</sup> – Ricki Wach-Cook.

**Discussion Items:**

1. Ben Hill led the discussion pertaining to the Trustland funded teacher grant requests. A summary sheet was provided for members to view with the proposed School Improvement Plan goals for 2017-18. There was an adjustment made to the summary in Goal #2. \$32,000 had been proposed to fund five base camp productivity classes. It was adjusted to four base camp classes and those funds were moved to Goal #4 to cover teacher stipends for a district required Canvas training that will take place during non-contract hours on August 3<sup>rd</sup> and August 4<sup>th</sup>. The following funding was discussed:

New funding 2018      \$168,763

2017 Carryover          \$9,000

Total available 2018   \$177,763

Current proposals      \$116,260

Remaining                \$61,503

It was proposed that the remaining \$61,503 be used to fund the teacher requests. Although there was \$130,729.80 requested by teachers - the administration was able to find other funding sources to offset the difference working toward granting the teacher proposals i.e. AP textbooks would be funded by AP funds. Jenny Pitt made a proposal to approve the entire funding package for the teacher proposal goals and School Improvement Plan spending for the 2017-18 school year – 2<sup>nd</sup> by Tanja Watts. The vote was unanimous. Updates were made to the School Improvement plan prior to the meeting with the new proposals in mind. Mr. Hill went through the entire document pointing out the updates. Tanja Watts made a motion to approve the 2017-18 School Improvement Plan – 2<sup>nd</sup> by Shalice Larsen. The voting was unanimous.

2. Principal Jason Smith gave a brief report on the school boundary study and information regarding the focus groups that are being assembled.
