If Seniors do not receive a final graduation checklist from his/her Counselor, then that senior is on track for graduation.

Final Graduation Checklist

The VHS Counseling Department has a process to clear Seniors for graduation. Students will not be ambushed by something on graduation day that would keep them from participating in the ceremony. Counselors will notify seniors of any possible reason they are not on track for graduation via the Final Graduation Checklist. Seniors in jeopardy of not graduating will receive their checklist on April 25th and 26th, giving them an opportunity make up any deficiencies before graduation on May 27th.

Seniors may not be on track for graduation for one or more of the following reasons:

- Missing academic credits
- A potential 4th term class fail
- U's from previous terms
- Potential U's for this term
- The US Citizenship test not passed



What happens if a senior fails a 4th term class?

Seniors who are otherwise on track for graduation but have a class listed on the Final Graduation Checklist as a potential class fail must work with the teacher, complete all needed assignments, quizzes and tests. Once the teacher is satisfied that the student will pass, the teacher will sign the Graduation Checklist and then the Counselor will clear the senior for graduation. If the student does not complete the needed requirements, as set forth by the teacher, then the student will not be allowed to participate in the graduation ceremony.

Can Students with U's Participate in the Graduation Ceremony

Citizenship is a graduation requirement. Students who have previous U's or potential 4th term U's must clear them with Mrs. McOmber in the Main Office. Students who may receive a U for 4th term will be notified by his/her Counselor via the Final Graduation Checklist.
