PURPOSE:

The Viewmont Alumni Association Scholarship was established to recognize children or grandchildren of Viewmont Alumni, who are graduating seniors of Viewmont High School, for their community service, citizenship and scholarship and to aid them financially in pursuing post secondary education. Community service entails reaching out to less fortunate members of the community at large in sharing an individual's resources, time, talents, and knowledge. Good citizenship encourages a student's positive relationships with other diverse members of the school and community by supporting laws and equal opportunities for all. Scholarship is the natural extension of life long learning.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

1. Must be a graduating senior of Viewmont High School.
2. One or more of applicant's parents or grandparents must have attended Viewmont.
Name of parent(s) or grandparent(s) who attended Viewmont:

3. May be nominated by a faculty or staff member who is not related to the applicant.
4. Must have met Viewmont citizenship requirements (which means no unsatisfactory demerits) at the time of the award.
5. Must be of good moral character and integrity and not have been charged with alcohol, drug abuse or violent behavior during the preceding three (3) years in high school.
6. Must have demonstrated community service, scholarship, exemplary citizenship, and leadership. Leadership positions at Viewmont:

7. Must submit an application and an essay explaining scholarship, community service, citizenship, and leadership qualifications and identifying the college or school to be attended.
8. Finalists may be asked to an oral interview.
9. Must use the funds within twelve (12) months of award for post high school education at an accredited community college, trade school or institution of higher learning (unless there is an approved exemption for missionary, military or other service).
10. Must not be receiving other scholarship funds, the amount of which exceed the actual cost of the education, tuition, fees and books.
11. A copy of the applicant's high school transcripts must be included with the application.
12. Must include written recommendations from two (2) teachers at Viewmont.
13. Application filing deadline April 24th, 2019

I hereby certify under penalties of perjury that I fully qualify and meet all the requirements set forth above and am eligible for the Viewmont Alumni Scholarship. I consent to the use of my name and picture as the Scholarship recipient if chosen. I understand that the Scholarship will be disbursed from the Davis School Foundation directly to my college or school only upon notification from the school of my enrollment, which must occur within twelve (12) months of graduation unless an exemption for missionary, military or other service is granted by the Alumni Association. I understand and agree that no other scholarship funds from any source may be received that will exceed the total amount of tuition and fees for the applicable school in the year the Alumni Scholarship will be utilized.
