High school name and address, or high school code (450032)

High school transcript

ACT score (often on transcript)

High school graduation date

Admission term requested (example: Fall 2023)

Length of time living in Utah (the application may ask for proof of residency, such as schooling or work history)

Driver's license or state ID card

Social Security Number

Method of payment for application fee (credit card or fee waiver)

- Priority Deadline: November 1-housing preference
 - Application Deadline: December 15
 - Scholarship Deadline: December 15
 - Separate Scholarship Application
 - ACT not required. If student chooses to apply with an ACT score, BYU must have an official score when application is submitted.
 - Application Fee: \$35
 - Transcript: Student puts in grades from transcript. BYU will request an official transcript once student is admitted.
 - Start Early! There are Essays and recommendations that take time
