**Fidelity:** Loyal to self, beliefs, family, friends; dedicated to honorable causes.

**Discipline:** A leader who says "as I do" rather than "as I say". Lifestyle of willpower.

**Hospitality:** Treating others with respect and dignity, regardless of who they are.

**Industriousness:** Work hard with pride. Consistent, well directed effort. High standards.

**Perseverance:** Actively standing up and returning from failure/defeat until successful.

**Self-Reliance:** Never waiting for someone else to be responsible. Create independence.
