Grade 12: FAFSA – Free Application for Federal Student Aid – Why complete the FAFSA? 1. Many scholarships require you to file the FAFSA (for example the Opportunity Scholarship) 2. It determines eligibility for federal and state financial aid like the Pell Grant. 3. Even if you do not qualify for the Pell Grant, you may be eligible to receive something. FAFSA=

Free Application For Federal Student Aid

Application opens October 1st

File the FAFSA ASAP your senior year.

Check your college's financial aid deadline, they vary.

Many scholarships require you to submit the FAFSA as part of the application process.

Everyone should submit even if you do not qualify for a Pell Grant– you never know unless you apply.

FAFSA completion night during PT conferences, Dec 5th.

FAFSA FAQ's



Income cut off?

It's impossible to identify an exact number, since the FAFSA also accounts for household size, number of children in college, proximity of parents to retirement, etc.

Deferment & FAFSA

File the FAFSA the fall of your senior year of high school even if you are planning on mission/military/humanitarian right after you graduate.

Financial Aid

To receive financial aid, submit a completed FAFSA and be fully admitted to the college.

Some colleges automatically consider you for aid if the needed requirements are met with the application and for other schools you will need to apply.


